# **Training days**

Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> and Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> of September are staff training days. Families new to the school will also be able to visit classrooms and meet key adults on the morning of Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> September, which we call our registration morning. Other training days planned for this academic year are: Friday 30<sup>th</sup> September, Monday 31<sup>st</sup> October and Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> January. ## Start of term

The new school year starts on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September for all children, though our reception classes are having a phased start and Mrs Loveless will have informed parents of the first days for the children in FS2.

Just a reminder that our school day will be slightly longer for FS2 to Y6 pupils:


- 0830hrs Gates open
